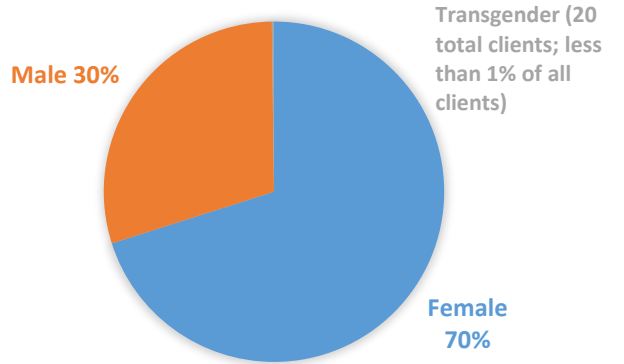

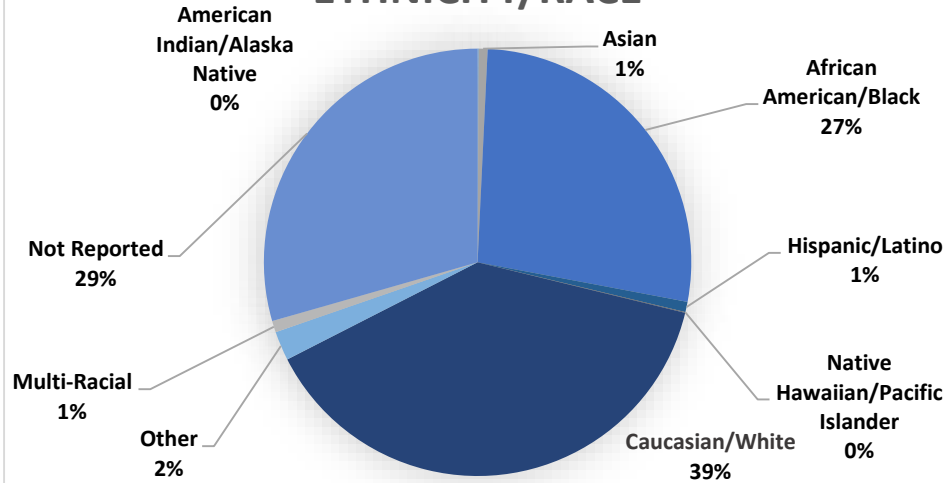
ALL CLIENTS BY AGE



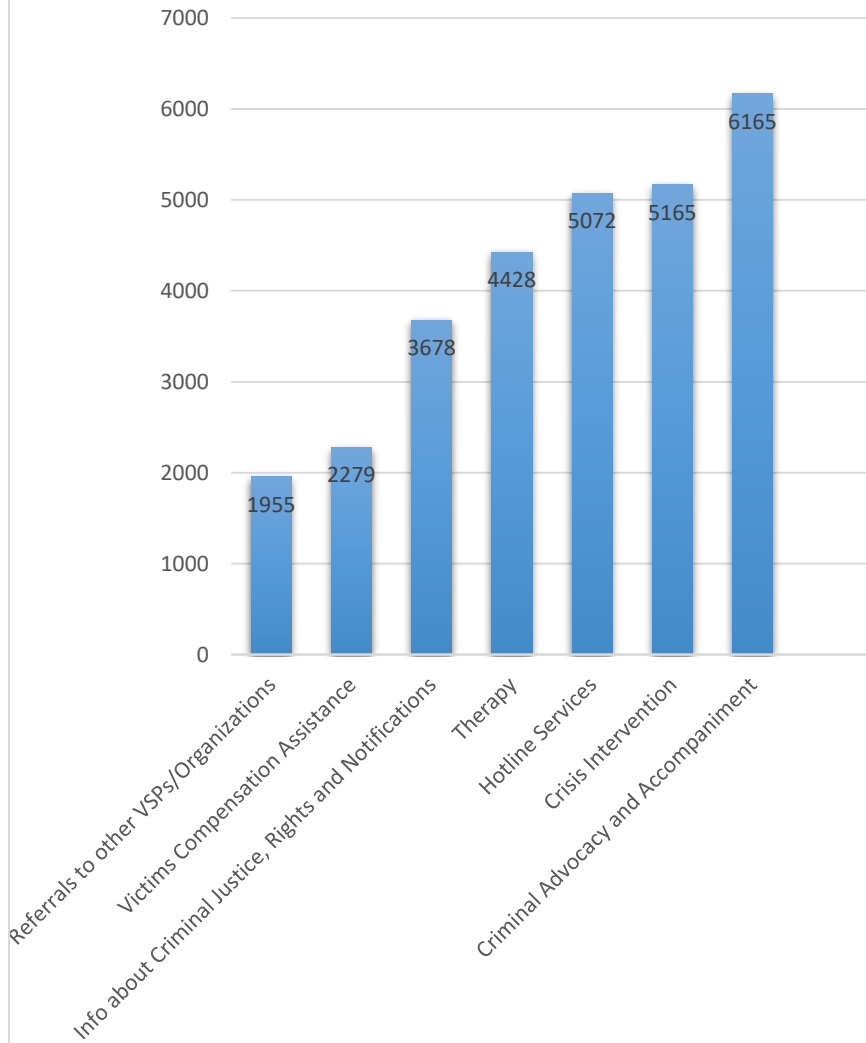
ALL CLIENTS BY SELF-IDENTIFIED GENDER
