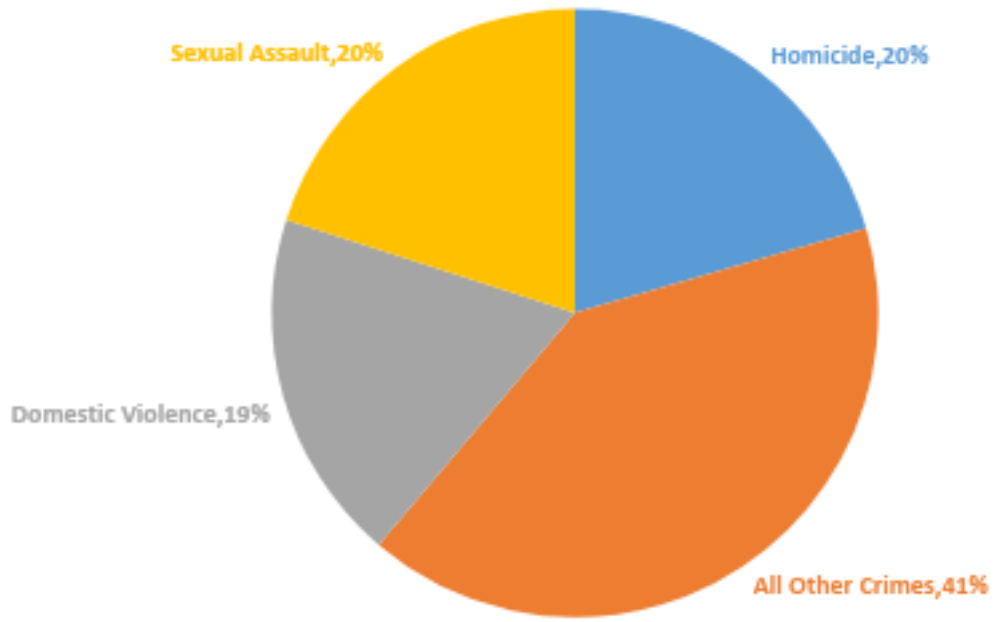

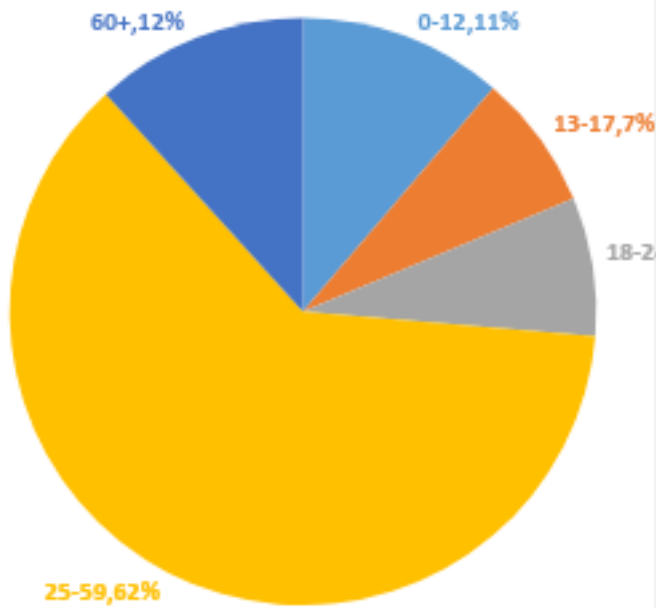

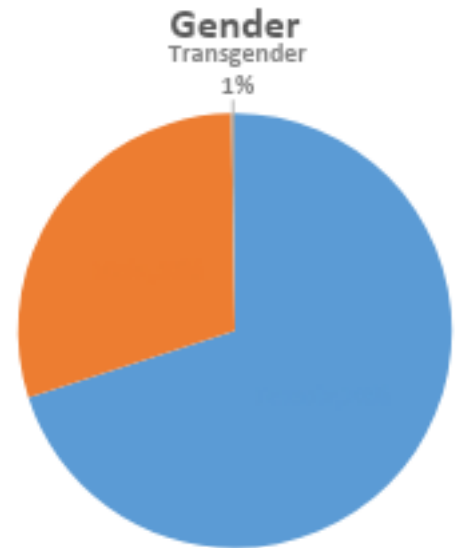
Type of Victimization - Clients Served



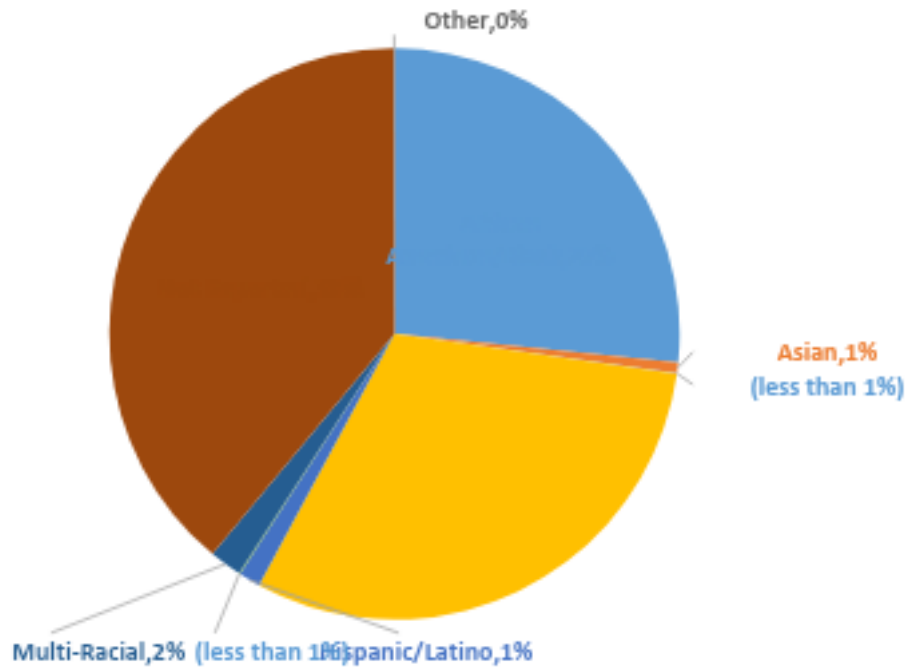
All Clients by Age



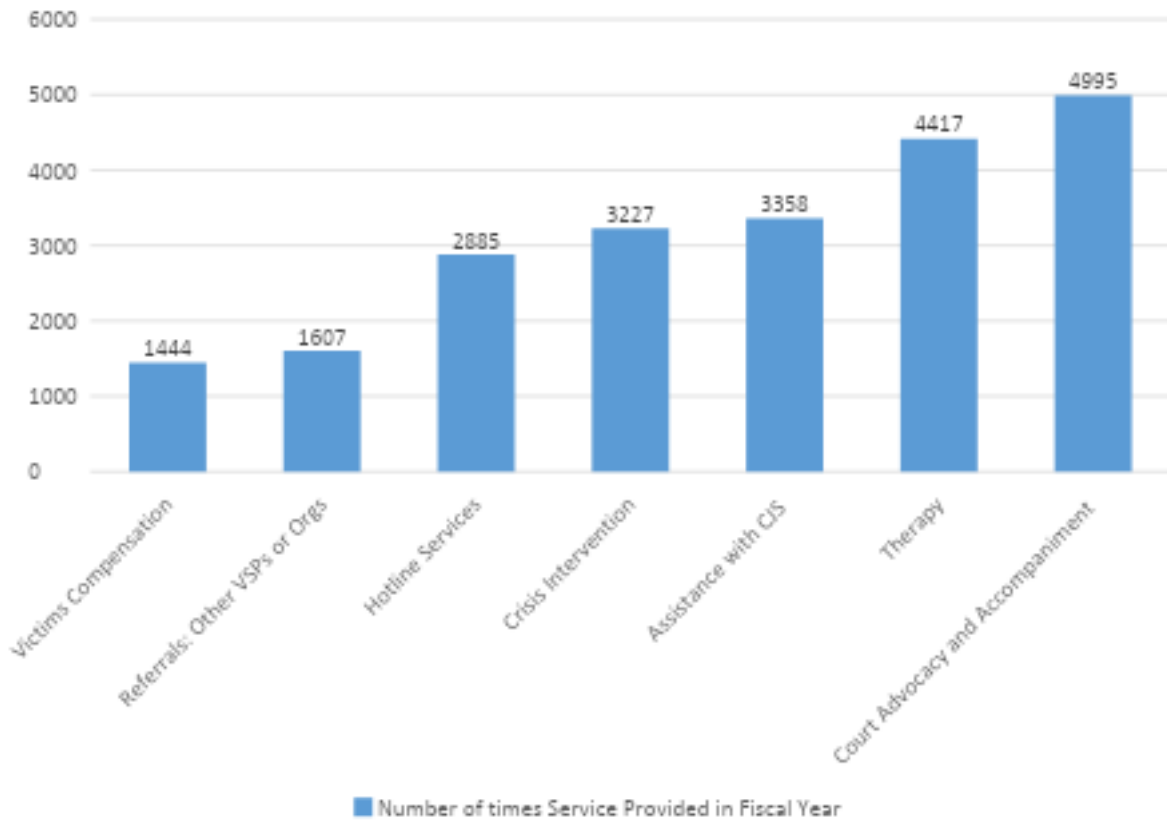
All Clients by Self-Identified Gender
